| | Art Smock – Easy to put on/take-off, preferably long sleeves and loose fitting (an old large, button down shirt would work great) |

| | One pair of wired, over the head, plain earphones in a 1 gallon Ziploc Bag labeled with name (no earbuds or wireless). These will stay at school. |
| | Gym Shoes: Students have P.E. daily. Soft sole shoes may be worn daily or may be kept in the students locker. |
| | Backpack: standard size that will fit inside a locker. No wheels |

Lockers: Primary school teachers ask that students <u>not</u> bring decorative items for the lockers; for example, gel clings, stickers, magnets, dry erase boards, photographs, hanging lamps, and rugs. While these things are fun for students, they create unnecessary distractions during the school day. Locker shelves will be permitted to help students separate and organize supplies, but any other novelty items will be sent home.
