Supplies

- □ 6 pack or higher glue sticks
- □ 4 boxes of tissues*
- □ 1 box of quart-sized Ziploc bags*
- □ 1 package of highlighters
- □ 1 package of black Expo markers
- □ 1 box of number 2 pencils
- □ 1 box of 24 count crayons
- □ 1 box of colored pencils
- □ 1 box of thin markers
- □ 1 box of thick markers
- □ 6 big pink erasers (these typically come in a two pack)
- □ 3 three-pronged green folders
- □ Sketch Pad for second grade room (*This can be just a single subject notebook*.)
- 2 packages of paper plates*

Additional Supplies

□ Art Smock Easy to put on/take-off, preferably long sleeves and loose fitting (an old large, button down shirt would work great)

□ Art Class: One 8 ¹/₂" x II" bound artist sketchbook – Canson and Blick bound sketchbook available online at <u>http://www.dickblick.com/products/blick-hardbound-sketchbook/</u>

Gym Shoes: Students have P.E. daily. Soft sole shoes may be worn daily or may be kept in the students locker.

□ One pair of wired, over the head, plain earphones in a I gallon Ziploc Bag labeled with name (no earbuds or wireless). These will stay at school.

- **Backpack:** standard size that will fit inside a locker. **No wheels**
- □ Homework Binder (size 8.5 x 5.5- if yours from last year is in good condition you may use it)

Lockers: Primary school teachers ask that students <u>not</u> bring decorative items for the lockers; for example, gel clings, stickers, magnets, dry erase boards, photographs, hanging lamps, and rugs. While these things are fun for students, they create unnecessary distractions during the school day. Locker shelves will be permitted to help students separate and organize supplies, but any other novelty items will be sent home.
