

PRIMARY SCHOOL DRESS CODE

The purpose of the Evansville Day School Primary School Dress Code is to provide guidance to the school community regarding appropriate attire. The dress code is also a means of encouraging students to reflect a sense of pride in respecting themselves, their classmates and the school community. The dress code strives to remove ambiguity so students and staff remain focused on the educational experience and learning outcomes.

PANTS:

- Relaxed fit or uniform style
- Solid colors: Navy, black, or khaki
- Shorts should extend past mid-thigh
- Leggings worn as pants are not approved for dress code

SHIRTS:

- Solid colored collared; polo style
- Short- or long-sleeved
- Small logo (up to 3") is permitted

SKIRTS/DRESSES:

- Skirts should be of Uniform style
- Solid color leggings and tights worn under skirts/dresses should be navy, black, white, or khaki.
- Collared polo style dresses or uniform style jumpers with a polo shirt are permitted.
- Skirts, skorts and dresses should extend past mid-thigh.

COOL-WEATHER ITEMS:

- Solid color sweaters, vests, or zip-up fleeces
- Hoods and sweatshirts are not permitted
- A solid color, collared shirt worn underneath
- Small logo (up to 3") is acceptable.

FOOTWEAR:

- Any well-kept athletic, casual, or dress shoe suitable for running and active play
- Backless shoes, Crocs, sandals, flip-flops, and high-heels are not permitted.

FRIDAY:

- Jeans (blue or black) may be worn on Friday and designated "jean days." (no holes or rips)
- EDS Spirit Wear or college/university shirts (including hoodies) may be worn.

Note: Hair must be of natural color.
