



2021-22 COVID-19 STUDENT POLICY

If your child exhibits symptoms that may be related to COVID-19, please keep them home and contact the school nurse to determine next steps and when it is safe to return to school.

UNVACCINATED



FACE MASKS

Masks are required for all students and visitors.

The CDC now recommends universal masking indoors, regardless of vaccination status in regions seeing case surges.

QUARANTINE

FULLY MASKED SCHOOL SETTING: No close contact quarantine required as long as asymptomatic and doing daily symptom check.

OTHER SETTINGS: Unvaccinated asymptomatic students who are identified as a close contact must quarantine. Asymptomatic close contacts may return on day 15 after last exposure.

VACCINATED



FACE MASKS

Masks are required for all students and visitors.

The CDC now recommends universal masking indoors, regardless of vaccination status in regions seeing case surges.

QUARANTINE

ALL SETTINGS: No close contact quarantine required with proof of vaccination as long as asymptomatic.

The CDC recommends fully vaccinated students with known exposure be tested 3-5 days after exposure and wear a mask in public indoor settings for 14 days, or until they receive negative PCR test result.

ISOLATION

Students who test positive for COVID-19 should stay home and isolate themselves from other household members for 10 days from the onset of symptoms or positive PCR test result.

Who is a close contact?

Individuals within 3 feet when masked or 6 feet unmasked for a total of 15 minutes or more in an indoor setting within a 24-hour period is considered a close contact.
