	Art Smock - Easy to put on/take-off, preferably long sleeves and loose fitting (an old large, button down shirt would work great)

or wire	One pair of wired, over the head, plain earphones in a 1 gallon Ziploc Bag labeled with name (no earbud less). These will stay at school.
