**Job Summary:** The Primary School encompasses Junior Pre-Kindergarten through grade 5. It is a collaborative environment that requires excellent communication and flexibility. In 2025-2026, this role will require instruction in 5th grade math, English Language Arts, and Social Studies. The math curriculum is Dimensions Math - training in Singapore mathematics instruction will be provided. Homeroom teachers engage in social-emotional and executive function support, as well as consistent and proactive communication with family members and other faculty. - Teach 5th grade English Language Arts, Social Studies, and Dimensions Math. Students are divided into two sections of 10-14 students each.

- Employ research-based and innovative instructional and assessment methods.
- Create a warm and well-structured learning environment with consistent routines and high expectations that encourages and supports intellectual risk-taking and growth.
- Provide timely individualized feedback to students.
- Communicate proactively with families.
- Serve as the homeroom teacher for 5th grade.
- Supervise students as assigned by Division Head.
- Contribute to the life of Day School by coaching and/or leading student clubs and activities.
- Be a visible presence at school events.
- Actively participate in the Mathematics and Humanities departments.
- Actively participate in faculty meetings and professional development.
- Model a commitment to lifelong learning and growth.
