# Friends of Evansville Day School November 15, 2021 Meeting Minutes

Financial Report: Provided by Treasurer Judith Kunst

Since our last meeting, Friends has earned \$3,077.50 from the following sources:

- from the Puppy Chow Sale: \$237.50
- from the Trivia Night table sales and mulligan/game sales: \$2840.00

Since our last meeting, Friends has incurred \$819.72 in expenses:

- from a late payment for the new Fall Festival booth decals: \$180.18
- from food and supplies purchased for the Trivia Night: \$639.54

With a net activity generated from activity during the past month of \$2,257.78, Friends has a bank balance of \$20,520.37.

School Store Fundraiser will continue online. There have been \$3,000 in gift cards purchased for teachers and we have received \$385.82 for starting the school store early this year.

- People had the option to prepurchase mulligans
- Food and drink were provided by Farm Boy, El Charro, Sugar Fix and Carson's Brewery with Carson's giving \$170 of proceeds back to Friends
- Trivia and costume contest winners donated their prize money back to Friends
