- We (I) understand and acknowledge that the use of sports equipment, facilities and services involves risks, and that a sport is inherently dangerous, and as such, voluntary participation in this activity might result in bodily injury and for property damage from the use of any equipment or facilities, from the activity itself, from the acts of others, or from the unavailability of emergency medical care. We (I) assume all risks related to the sporting activity and release Evansville Day School, employees and agents, the heirs and assigns, officers, and agree not to sue them on account of or in conjunction with any claims, causes of action, injuries, damage, or cost of expenses arising out of the activity, including those based on death, bodily injury or property damage whether or not caused by the acts, omissions or other fault of the parties being released. We (I) waive the protection afforded by any statute or law in any jurisdiction whose purpose, substance, and/or effect is to provide that a general release shall not extend to claims, material or otherwise which the person giving the release does not know of or suspect at the time of executing the release. This means, in part, that we (I) release unknown future claims.

TERMS AND CONDITIONS FOR SUMMER ACADEMY

- A. Evansville Day School believes that a positive and constructive working relationship between Evansville Day School and a student and his or her parent(s) and /or guardian(s) is essential to the fulfillment of Evansville Day School's mission. In consideration and acknowledgment of this belief, I/we agree to accept and honor the rules, regulations, and policies of Evansville Day School and its Head of School's decisions, including those in existence as of the date hereof as well as all additions, substitutions, and modifications that may be subsequently adopted. I/we understand that Evansville Day School reserves the right to decline re-enrollment, dismiss, or require withdrawal of the student at any time during the summer, if Evansville Day School concludes that the action of the student or a parent or guardian makes such a positive and constructive relationship impossible or otherwise seriously interferes with Evansville Day School's accomplishment of its mission.
 - In the event the student, individually or with others, damages school property intentionally, recklessly, or in violation of school policy or the law, full restitution must be made by the student and/or the undersigned. Any failure to make restitution will be considered a default.
- B. The privileges of the School may be denied to any student whose family/guardian is unable to meet their financial obligation to the School. The School reserves the right to deny attendance to students whose accounts include overdue balances.
- C. The facilities of our program are designed only for children who are toilet trained. Therefore, all enrolled children must be toilet trained to attend classes at Evansville Day School.
- D. We (I) grant permission to school officials to secure emergency medical or dental treatment, hospital service, or laboratory fees for the student at the parents' or guardian's expense.
- E. We (I) hereby give permission for the student to go on adult-supervised excursion tours and field trips planned by the School, and to use Evansville Day School's library, computer and internet resources, according to school rules.
- F. We (I) expressly agree to the participation by the student in any activities of the Evansville Day School, including but not limited to classes, recess, physical education, dining, school-sponsored trips away from campus, and any other school-related activity or extracurricular activity, and the use of any school facility or property.
- G.
