Why is this scholarship being offered?

[Evansville Day School](#) understands educators have chosen a profession with immeasurable societal impact, but with lower salary benefits as compared to other fields requiring similar degrees and work demands. As the leading secondary school in the region, we want to recognize college educators by making Day School [affordable](#) to those families who value our [mission](#) and brand of education. We know educators are particularly supportive of other educators and make terrific partners in their child's scholastic experience.

Who is eligible for this scholarship?

Any student whose parent(s) work (full- or part-time) for Youth First, and who are mission appropriate for Evansville Day School as determined by the [admission](#) process. Parents must be employed by Youth First at the time of enrollment in order to qualify.

What is the amount of the scholarship?

Scholarships depend upon the grade level of the student and are awarded at 25% for Junior Pre-K and Pre-K and 50% for K - Grade 12. The tuition chart is available [here](#).

Is this a one-time award?

No. Scholarships are automatically renewed annually.

What is the scholarship deadline?

There is no specific deadline to apply for admission, or to apply for this scholarship, however; applicants are encouraged to apply early as several grade levels fill up prior to the start of school.

Can scholarship recipients also apply for need-based financial aid?

Yes. The scholarship is the minimum amount of tuition assistance students receive. If the financial aid process demonstrates need beyond the scholarship amount, the school grants the family the larger award. Financial aid is not available in JPK and PK (beyond the 25% scholarship).
