- 8 Elmer Glue Sticks – purple tint
- 2 packs Crayola **Original** 10 count markers
- 3 packs Crayola **Original** 24 count crayons
- Scissors – child's pointed tip
- 4 pk of thin multi-color highlighters
- 4 pk of thin Expo dry erase markers
- Two 12 pk of **pre-sharpened** pencils
- 2 two-pocket red folders with fasteners
- 2 composition notebooks (wide rule)
- 1- 1/2" Durable View Avery binder
- 1 box of quart-sized Ziploc bags*
- 4 boxes of tissues*
- 2 packs of paper plates*

Additional Supplies

- Shoes:** For school, please purchase shoes that your child can manage **independently**.
- Backpack:** standard size that will fit inside a locker. **No wheels**
- Spare change of season appropriate clothing** – store in the top of the locker
- Sharing bag** – a pillowcase or similar bag for transporting sharing items to and from school each week – keep in a backpack or at home. Sharing will begin in September.
- Gym Shoes:** Students have P.E. daily. Soft sole shoes may be worn daily or may be kept in the students locker.
- Art Smock** Easy to put on/take-off, preferably long sleeves and loose fitting (an old large, button down shirt would work great)
- Art Class: One 8 1/2" x 11" bound artist sketchbook** – Canson and Blick bound sketchbook available online at <http://www.dickblick.com/products/blick-hardbound-sketchbook/>
- One pair of wired, over the head, plain earphones** in a 1 gallon Ziploc Bag labeled with name (no earbuds or wireless). These will stay at school.

Lockers: Primary school teachers ask that students **not** bring decorative items for the lockers; for example, gel clings, stickers, magnets, dry erase boards, photographs, hanging lamps, and rugs. While these things are fun for students, they create unnecessary distractions during the school day. Locker shelves will be permitted to help students separate and organize supplies, but any other novelty items will be sent home.
