- ☐ 100 Clear plastic sheet protectors
- ☐ Crayola watercolors - washable, 8 assorted colors
- ☐ Crayola Washable Markers (any variety)
- ☐ 48 count Crayola crayons
- ☐ 2 Packages of card stock paper (1 assorted colors and one black or white)
- ☐ 1 package of press and seal envelopes
- ☐ Baby wipes
- ☐ Sandwich sized Ziploc bags
- ☐ Bubbles
- ☐ Outdoor chalk
- ☐ Plastic folder with pockets (any color)
- ☐ One bottle of foaming hand soap

Additional Supplies

- ☐ Rain boots/snow boots for colder weather
- ☐ Extra clothes: dress code shirt, pants, shoes, socks and underwear

- ☐ Sun hat and sunglasses (*optional*)
- ☐ Warm hat, snow pants, waterproof mittens for colder weather
- ☐ Spray or roll-on sunscreen as well as a face stick sunscreen and bug spray.
- ☐ Shoes: For school, please purchase shoes that your child can manage independently. Velcro or slip-on shoes work best for most children this age. Shoes should cover toes and the back of the heel.

Lockers: We ask that students not bring decorative items for the lockers; for example, gel clings, stickers, magnets, dry erase boards, photographs, hanging lamps, and rugs.
