Supplies

	Binder - durable view, 1 ½" white, Avery
	100 Clear plastic sheet protectors
	Crayola watercolors - washable, 8 assorted colors
	2 rolls Washi tape (any pattern/color)
	16 count Crayola crayons
	2 Packages of card stock paper (1 assorted colors and one black)
	4 count package of Playdough (any color)
	Baby wipes
	Gallon Ziploc bags
	Outdoor chalk
	Plastic folder with pockets (any color)
	Dry erase markers (assorted colors)
	Standard sized backpack (must be able to fit a folder/lunch box/etc)
Additional Supplies	
	Rain boots/snow boots for colder weather
	Extra clothes: dress code shirt, pants, shoes, socks and underwear
	Dishwasher safe, spill proof water bottle (child size)
	Velco nap mat (Not the mat from the School Supply Store.) Please send a mat with an attached blanket and pillow that also closes with Velcro. Wildkin is a wonderful brand that holds up through weekly washings and will last for PK. It can be purchased through Amazon.
	Sun hat and sunglasses (optional)
	Warm hat, snow pants, waterproof mittens for colder weather
	Spray or roll-on sunscreen as well as a face stick sunscreen and bug spray.
	Shoes: For school, please purchase shoes that your child can manage independently. Velcro or slip-on shoes work best for most children this age. Shoes should cover toes and the back of the heel.

Lockers: We ask that students not bring decorative items for the lockers; for example, gel clings, stickers, magnets, dry erase boards, photographs, hanging lamps, and rugs. While these items are fun for students, they can create unnecessary distractions during the school day. Locker shelves have been provided for the JPK students to help separate and organize supplies.
